Last Year

- Last year we charged \$130 per scout. So where does the money go?
 - \$44 to national scouts organization
 - \$10 for boys life
 - The rest went to the pack to cover awards, events and campouts. \$76

Last year

 So we collected about \$75 a scout, which is not enough to run the pack actually.

 Yearly we run the cost is about \$200 per scout (goes up and down a little with the number of scouts)

The difference is made up in fundraising & Popcorn.

This Year

- The national fee has increased to \$66.
 - It actually increased last year but a good popcorn made it possible for us not to ask for more money last year.
- A regional fee of \$54 has been added this year
- Boys life is the same \$10
- So that is \$130 before the pack gets any revenue



Still going higher

- So we are starting at \$130 and now we have to add what the pack needs.
- This year we are not funding any of cub family weekend or food on campouts.
- This gets us to we need \$150 a scout to function for the year.
 - There is very little popcorn sales to help this year

Our Proposal

- We hate asking for \$130 + \$150 = \$280
- With so much unknown, we don't want to hold to money we might not need or use.
- So the fees
 - Now \$205 = covers \$130 and \$75 (half of the pack costs)
 - Please pay through Paypal friends and family admin@pack23tallahassee.com
 - In Jan collect the remaining \$75
 - If we can have some fundraising, this number will decrease
 - If we shutdown, we won't need to collect your funds and use the \$75 for the new year
